1. **Louvre** – closed Tues – open 9-18 – open till 21:45 Wed & Fri
2. **Orsay** – closed Monday – open 10-18 – opens at 9 on sun – til 21:45 on Thursday
3. **Rodin Museum** – closed Monday – open 9:30-17:45
4. **Versailles** (not on map) – closed Monday – 9-18:30
5. **Eiffel Tower** (and the incredible view of it from across the Seine at the Palais de Chaillot) – daily 9-midnight
6. **Arc de Triumph** – daily 10-23
7. **Montmartre** – Sacre Coeur is open daily 7-23,
8. **Napoleon’s Tomb** (in the Hotel des Invalides)– open daily 10-18 and surrounded by the military museum –
9. **Notre Dame** – daily 9:30-19:30 for the climb to the top –
10. **Catacombs** – closed mon – open 10-17 – (denfert-rochereau metro look for the lion in traffic circle and if he looked left he’d look right at the green entrance) 1, avenue of Colonel Henri Rol-Tanguy
11. **Place Des Vosges** – just up and to the right of the Ile St Louis – a beautiful square
12. **Picasso museum** – in the marais – closed Tuesday – 9:30-6:00
13. **Musée de l’Orangerie** – Monet paintings – in the Tuilleries – Closed Tuesdays and May 1st
14. **Cruise on the Seine** – catch the boat at the Eiffel Tower - Place Des Vosges
